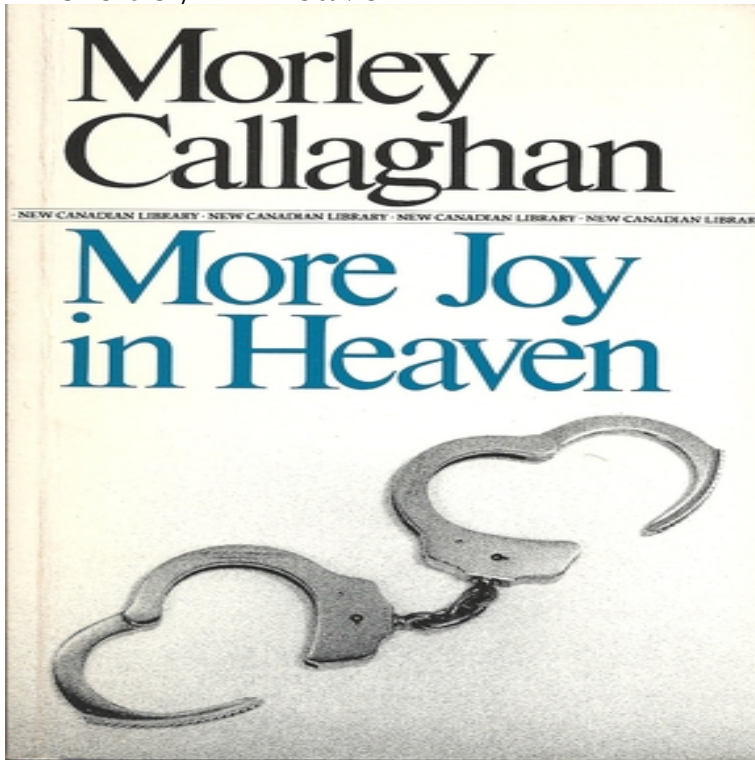


## More Joy In Heaven
